New York, December 6, 2013 – Collective Design Fair announced today the first round of participating galleries for its second edition, which will be held in Manhattan from May 8 through May 11, 2014. Collective 2 will host a dynamic mix of emerging and established international exhibitors presenting a cohesive selection of contemporary and 20th-century design. In addition, four leading cultural institutions have joined this year as Official Cultural Partners.

Collective 2 will have numerous international exhibitors joining for 2014, including London's 88 Gallery, Paris' Galerie BSL and Mexico City's ADN Galería. New domestic participants include Gallery SEOMI of Los Angeles and Seoul, Dienst + Dotter Antikviteter of New York City and Moderne Gallery of Philadelphia. Among the many returning exhibitors are Cristina Grajales Gallery, Maison Gerard, Modernity, R 20th Century and Volume Gallery.

In addition, Collective is pleased to announce its first four Official Cultural Partners for 2014: The Glass House, the Museum of Arts and Design, The New Museum and the Smithsonian's Cooper-Hewitt, National Design Museum. These institutions will contribute to Collective's diverse slate of programming, to include special installations and Collective Conversations featuring designers, gallerists, educators and cultural innovators exploring vital topics in the field of design.

"In May, our goal is for visitors to again discover design from a wide-ranging group of international exhibitors inside a new venue that provides a quintessential New York experience," says Steven Learner, Founder and Creative Director of Collective Design Fair. "To challenge expectations of what a design fair can be, and where it can be, is essential to the spirit of Collective. We are excited to have a number of new galleries join us for our second edition, helping Collective to grow and making it a destination for connoisseurs, collectors, educators and visitors new to design."

Collective 2 will run concurrently with Frieze New York and the May art auctions, as the inaugural fair did in 2013, confirming its status as a key event on the city's cultural calendar. Amplifying its mission to celebrate both design history and innovation, Collective 2 will take place at Skylight at Moynihan Station, located in the historic James A. Farley Post Office, a McKim, Mead & White-designed Beaux-Arts building on Manhattan's West Side, at 8th Avenue and West 33rd Street.
